| In the event of a collapse / Myocardial infarction (MI), what is the transfer process for a patient? | There is 24-hour telephone access to the Northern Territory Department of Health Remote Health District Medical Officer (RMP/DMO). When emergency evacuations are necessary, health centre will staff provide medical care as per the CARPA manual and direction of the DMO while waiting for the arrival of a doctor and/or Careflight staff. |
